Press Release: Mini-Market Decontamination & careFIJI QR code

The Suva City Council is stepping up its containment efforts to ensure that various parts of the greater Suva area are safe from COVID-19.

The Council has been decontaminating public domains such as the Suva Municipal Market, bus station, retail outlets, and is now extending its efforts to the Mini-Markets.

Four mini-markets – Raiwaqa, Bailey Bridge, Flagstaff, and Nabua – will be decontaminated on Wednesday, July 14, 2021, from 4 pm to 7 pm. The SCC will work after hours to avoid any disruption provided by vendors during the day.

QR Codes using careFiji app

Suva and Lami Town Councils have been provided with QR codes for use with the careFIJI App for check-in and check-out. These QR Codes will be placed at the entrance and exit points.

When employees, customers, and visitors arrive, they may scan the QR Code with their careFIJI app, and they shall scan it again when they leave. This service will also be available at the Suva and Lami Municipal Markets.

The Council is pleased to work with the Ministry of Health and Medical Services, MCTTT and the Fijian Police Force to promote the vaccination drive in Suva and Lami, as well as decontamination efforts, QR codes, face masks, and social distancing enforcement.
