Suva City Council is organizing a White Goods collection program from Monday 18th of March to Saturday 6th of April, 2024 for Suva City residential areas and Suva Extended Town Boundaries. This program is for the residential citizens interested to remove damaged or unused white goods (Household Appliance) from properties.

Collection schedule date shall be:

Saturday 23 rd - Tuesday 26 th March 2024	SAMABULA WARD – (<i>Samabula /Vatuwaqa / Raiwasa /Rifle Range</i>)
Wednesday 27 th , Thursday 28 th March and Tuesday 2 nd April, 2024	TAMAVUA WARD – (<i>Tamavua/Nabua/Namadi Heights / Bayview / Walu Bay</i>)
Tuesday 2 nd - Thursday 4 th April 2024	TACIRUA PLAINS & TAMAVUA HEIGHTS – (<i>Cunningham Stages 1-4; Whippy Street, NLTB Subdivision; Upper Wailoku; Princess Road to Cunningham junction</i>).

Friday 5 th – Saturday 6 th April 2024	Tacirua Height stage 1 Housing Subdivision (Vunisinu Rd, Waqanui Rd, Natuvukica Rd, Valetabu Rd, Valewatu Rd, Nacoqio Rd, Naqumu Rd, Nawame Rd, Naisogoluvu Rd, Naiocovuaka Rd)

Please take note that:

- All white goods for collection are to be placed in one heap at a convenient and accessible point and shall not be placed more than (2) days earlier than the schedule collection days.
- Residents are required to pack small items such as tins, bottles etc. inside a sack or cartons.
- The normal monthly green waste collection services shall continue as per normal schedule.
- Does not include commercial refuse or any refuse generated from building construction or any industrial work and shall be restricted to residential refuse only.
